Lafite 2016: Quality score vs ex-négociant price per bottle (€)

With a similar Quality score to 2009 and 2010, which are currently worth £617 and £564 per bottle in the market respectively, and given Lafite's historical performance post release, 2016's 8% increase on 2015's release price initially looks measured, but with only two thirds released and most Bordeaux négociants awaiting the second tranche, it remains to be seen what the real price will be and whether this is as good a buy as it first appears.

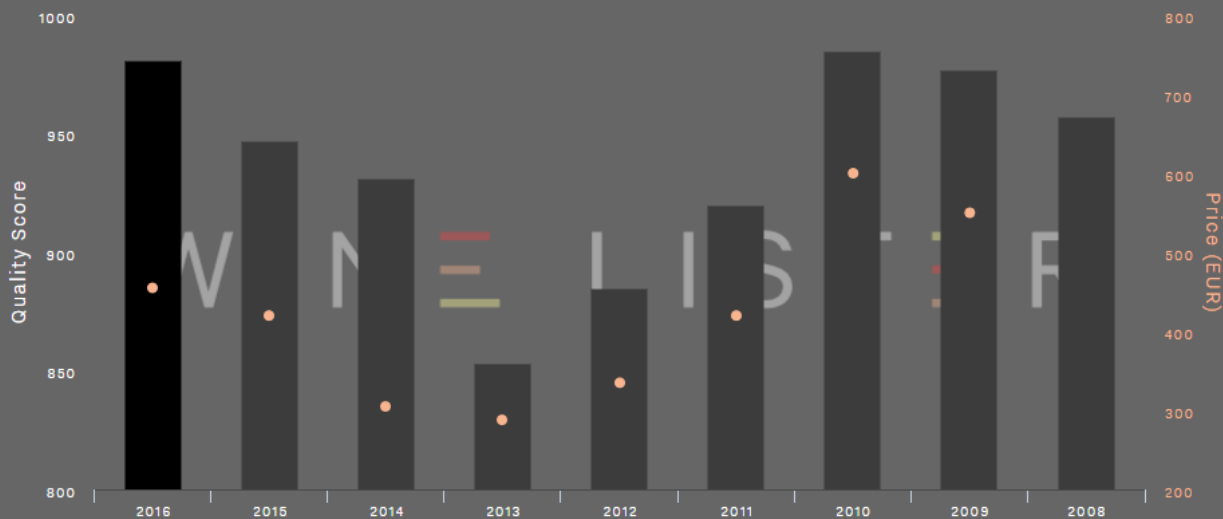

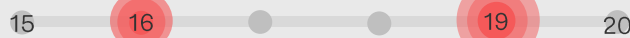
